

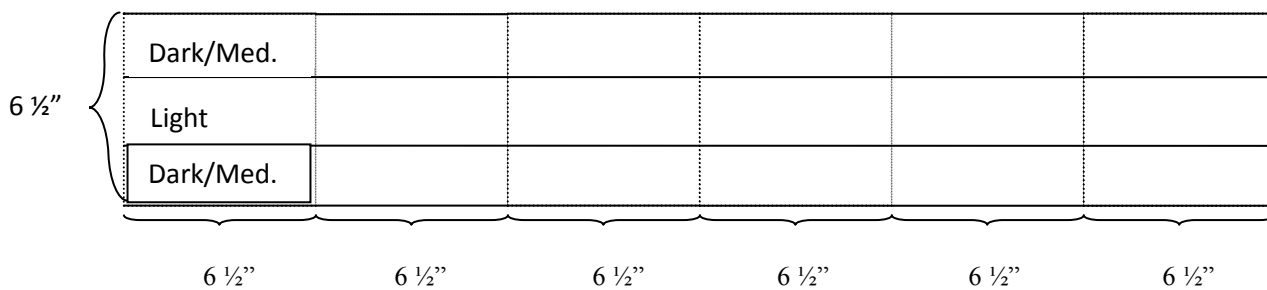
Strip Poker

Originally designed by Rita Fishel as Patriotic Ribbons.

Finished Size: 42" x 60"

Blocks – Make a Total of 70:

- Sew a dark/medium strip to opposite sides of a light strip. Press the seams toward the medium/dark strips. Make a total of 12 strip sets. The width of these strip sets should be $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".



- Cut each strip set into 6 – $6\frac{1}{2}$ " segments. You will have two blocks leftover. (If the width of your strip sets was NOT $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", adjust the width of these segments accordingly. They must be square.)
- Lay out these blocks with seams going in alternate directions in seven rows of 10 blocks. Press seams toward alternate blocks in each row so that rows will go together more easily.
- Sew these seven rows together, butting seams to form your completed quilt top.
- Quilt as Desired.
